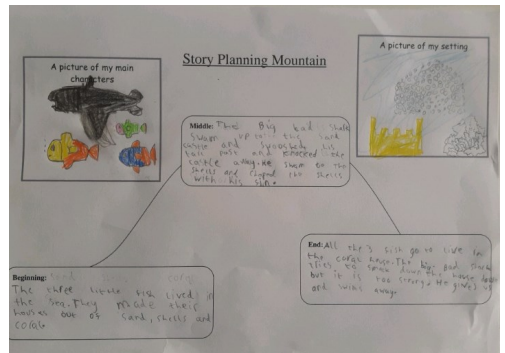

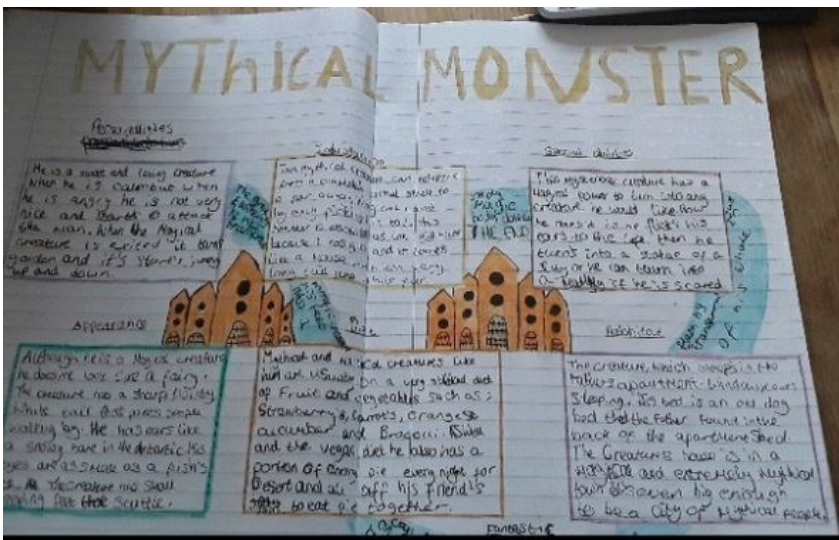
Dear Diary
