#### STAFFING UPDATE

Dear Parents/Carers,


The following procedures will now be in place for parents wishing to contact us...

- 1. Please call or email our school office directly on 01675470379 or at enquiry@curdworth.warwickshire.sch.uk. The school office hours are 8.30am until 3.30pm. The answerphone will be on outside of these times and any emails or messages left will be responded to as soon as possible. Please do not contact staff directly via email/dojo as they may not see these messages.
- 2. If your request/query is not urgent, please allow the teacher up to 2 working days to return your call/email. They all teach full-time and their breaks are used for planning, marking and getting ready for the following lessons.
- 3. Teachers will make calls to parents up until 4.30pm but not after that time. Managing teachers workload and mental health is important for us all. 4. Please note, if you do have concerns please follow this path:
