Class Dojo comms

Please use Class Dojo to communicate with your child's class teacher. If you require an urgent message to be sent to your child's class teacher, DO NOT class dojo, instead call the school office.

Teachers are teaching between the hours of 8.45am & 3.15pm. Teachers will aim to respond to your messages as soon as possible, but please give them at least 48 hours to respond.

Staff will not respond to messages after 6pm or before 7am, or on weekends.

Call the school office should any other family/friend be collecting your child, who is not involved in 'regular' collection/scheduled days.

If your child is ill, parents MUST PHONE and use the child absence option to record. Class Dojo messages will NOT be accepted.
